

Distinguished Alumnus John Lipori, LC'77, Retired Bank Executive, Served on Livingston College Dean's Advisory Council

John S. Lipori, a retired bank executive, was one of the first four Livingston College Distinguished Alumni, honored in 2000.

Lipori, a 1977 graduate of Livingston College at Rutgers University, served as National Director of Portfolio Management at BNY Mellon from 2010 until his retirement in 2015.

Lipori had previously served as Executive Vice President (EVP) and Chief Trust Officer of BNY Mellon Wealth Management and EVP at The Bank of New York, after joining the Bank in 1979.

He has served as a Trustee of the Variety Preschooler's Workshop in Syosset, NY, a nonprofit organization that works with handicapped preschool children and their families.

He has also served as the Chair of Livingston College's Dean's Advisory Council and as a member of the Rockefeller University's Committee on Trusts and Estate Gift Plans.
