Inauguration of President Holloway



Jonathan Scott Holloway was named the 21st president of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey and assumed the position on July 1, 2020. Due to the pandemic, we were introduced to Dr. Holloway via Zoom and heard him talk about a beloved community and the excellence here at Rutgers. A year later, under CDC guidance the university reopened. Students, faculty and staff returned to campus and we were able to finally celebrate and conduct the [inauguration](#) for our new President on

November 4-5, 2021.
